Nursery Remote Learning Letter Writing







You will need
Pens and pencils, paper or special writing set or card

What to do

Talk about the people you know who you haven't seen for a while. Explain that we have lots of ways to communicate when we can't visit people, but one lovely way is to send a letter or card. Who would love to hear from us/has a special day coming up? Spend some time talking about the person you are going to write to and the sorts of things they would like to read about.

Write the letter or card together, taking turns to write. Don't worry if your child only writes a few marks, letters or words they can dictate more ideas for you to write for them. Children learn about writing through watching you scribe for them.

Read the letter back together as you go and talk about how the receiver will feel when they get the letter.
