



How we will share your child's learning and development with you at The Lawns Pre-Nursery



Settling In

Following our induction visits the children's start dates are staggered so that each child has 1:1 time with their key person to support their settling. In their first few weeks your child's key person will talk you through a settling in sheet with photos and comments about what they have been doing. This information will be used for initial starting points and informs our planning of the provision, curriculum and environment.

Come in and talk

Talk to us – we have an open-door policy. This allows us to liaise at drop off and pick up. We will also have regular progress meetings through the year. If these times are not convenient for you please email or ring and we can arrange a time to talk to your child's key person.

Progress Discussions

Each term we ask you to come and talk with us about your child's learning and development. We will share photos of our teaching and your child's learning and together with your knowledge we can make the best plans for their future progress.

Website

Read the monthly Newsletters, these will be emailed each month and are also available on the website. The newsletters will show you a snap shot of the learning that month and suggest ways that you can support your child's learning at home. If your child is unable to attend Pre-Nursery our website has a remote learning section where you will find stories, songs and poems read by the adults at Pre-Nursery and a selection of ideas and activities to try at home linked to our curriculum.

Environment

Come in and see our environment each day. Our learning environment inside and outside is planned for children's development across the curriculum. The resources are accessible to support each child's own enquiry, curiosity and independence. Each day the adults set up based on the interests, fascinations and learning from the previous day. Resources and displays are designed to develop skills, knowledge and vocabulary.

Learning Journey Folder

Your child's folder will illustrate their learning journey through the year. The children will be encouraged and supported to add anything they create. The adults will add photos and wow moments each term and we welcome parents/ carers to take them home and add special moments they enjoy together for the children to tell us all about.

Curriculum

Our teams have designed and planned our curriculum full of rich and challenging activities and experiences designed to spark the children's curiosity, engage them and encourage deep learning and thinking.

2 Year Old Progress Checks

Each child will receive a 2 Year Old Progress Check during their time in Pre-Nursery. This will celebrate your child's development in each area of our curriculum and it will be written alongside you.
