

Nursery Remote Learning DIY Telephone



You will need:

Plastic cups, string and paint to decorate your telephone (optional)

What to do

The string telephone is the perfect experiment to explain to your children about sound waves at the same time as encouraging them to talk. When we speak, our vocal cords vibrate. Ask your child to hum a song while holding their hands against their throats to feel the vibration. The vibration is what creates sound.

To make the adult cuts a small slit on the bottom of each paper cup and cuts 1m string. Grab the end of the string through the cup and tie a knot.

Hold a cup each and walk away from each other until the string is taut.

Your creation is ready to have a conversation through.
