Speech Technique of the Month

Have conversations

Making comments instead of asking questions will encourage your child to respond. Try to make four comments about what you child is doing or saying before asking them a question.

Pause between sentences to give your child time to process what you are saying . Give them 10 seconds at least to respond.

Young children find it easier to talk about something they are looking at or doing.






Dates for Your Diary

A couple of reminders...

- If your child is unwell please don't bring them into Nursery. Colds and stomach bugs circulate quickly and this does then affect the children and staff team considerably. Please remember to call and let us know why your child is absent on the first day. Any child suffering from a stomach bug should not come into Nursery for 48 hours from their last symptom.
- Please park considerably around the Nursery at drop off and collection.
