What a fabulous week we have had this week in Nursery. We have particularly enjoyed creating an obstacle course which included climbing up the cargo net, this helped us to achieve part of one of our curriculum goals. We were impressed by the many different ways used to cross the obstacle course such as balancing, sliding and crawling. These movements help us to develop our core strength, gross motor skills and co-ordination. Following instructions and working towards a goal are skills integral in enabling children to engage in learning so that they can sit still, focus and concentrate. In addition, physical activity also helps to develop a healthy body, social and emotional well-being.

We really loved welcoming many of our parents and carers into nursery to take part in our 'Stay and Play' (come and read) session. The visitors read books with the children and this was an excellent way of demonstrating the value of books and encouraging a lifelong love of reading. The children were so happy to spend time demonstrating their favourite activities to their grown-ups and some took pride in sharing their Learning Journey folders.
