This week – 11th to 15th March

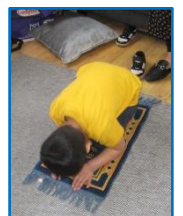
We were all delighted to see that the seeds we planted last week have started to germinate. The stem and the leaves are starting to grow and we are checking for changes every day. As well as the scientific concepts we are using mathematical language as we measure and compare which ones are taller, shortest etc.



We consolidated our knowledge of stories as we continued retelling The Three Little Pigs story together. We used our construction skills to create houses for the pigs, talking about different ways to stop the wolf blowing it down. We looked at different types of homes around the world to inspire our own creations. Some of the houses were extravagant, with many different rooms, some were tiny but perfectly formed. The children worked together using their problem-solving skills, collaboration and communication skills.



Some of the children have been excited to tell us about their family starting Ramadan this week. Decorations have generously been donated and families have been in to tell us about Ramadan for them. Children showed us their prayer mats, showing us the respectful way they use them, taking shoes off and Zamzam showed us how she covers her hair just like her mum.
