Monday 18th March to Friday 22nd March

This week at nursery we loved participating in a spring walk around Oakfield's Nature Trail, it was so much fun to go on a trip and spot lots of signs of spring (such as blossoms, daffodils, and buds on the trees). Lots of us spotted ladybirds on the logs which became a big highlight. It was peaceful on the trail, so we were able to practise our listening skills to hear birdsong and insects buzzing around.

We continued using our observation skills at group time to look at daffodils in a vase. The children used magnifying glasses, so they were able to see the flowers in detail. They loved telling us about what they had observed and were encouraged to use scientific vocabulary to talk about shape, texture, and colours. The children all did such a fantastic job of drawing and painting their very own bunch of daffodils. The wonderful array of yellow, orange and greens have really brightened up the Nursery.

Having listened to the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' we extended our learning by working together to retell the story using small world parts. The children especially enjoyed building the straw and wood houses so the Big Bad Wolf could come and blow them back down!
