This half term we will be working towards our 'Create' learning goal. During our time together we will be looking at the work of the artist Jackson Pollock. The children will then create their own paintings using different paintbrushes and pipettes to emulate the 'drip technique. We can't wait to see all of their individual ideas come to life.

We will also be playing a brilliant listening game at nursery in which familiar objects will be put in a box and the children will listen to each sound and try guess what the object might be!
