



Our Learning



Weekly update 17th - 21st March

This week's dry, sunny weather has enabled lots of active and physical outdoor learning. The children have been challenging themselves and each other to make obstacle courses where they need to balance, jump and slide.

We have been learning about composition of the number 3. It is made up of 1 and 1 and 1 or 2 and 1 or 3 and 0. We can subitise 3 objects (we don't need to count, we can see the amount). We played a game where we throw 3 bean bags into a hoop. We then use a sentence to describe what we notice. "There is one bean bag inside the hoop and 2 outside the hoop, 3 altogether." Or "There are 3 bean bags inside the hoop and 1 outside the hoop, 3 altogether". However the beanbags landed there were always 3!

Around the nursery we have continued to notice amounts of objects and point them out. "I can see 2 pirates." "I can see 1 button, another 1 and another 1, that's 3 altogether!"

We spend time developing this in-depth knowledge of the simple numbers to 5 before moving onto large numbers so the foundations are secure.
