## This Week

Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March

We have really enjoyed finding out about recycling this week which is part of the third milestone of our learning goal 'Nature'. We talked about how it was important to recycle as it reduces waste and helps keep parks and oceans clean for animals and people. We showed the children the recycling sign and then played an interesting game where they had to sort some rubbish into bins that were labelled with either a recycling sign or a waste bin sign. We are looking forward to seeing the children using their knowledge of recycling to sort items into the correct bins at tidy up time.

This Thursday is world book day. During our time together we have been excited to explore some of the books that they might get with their book token. This has really helped the children to understand that print conveys meaning as we read together, turning the pages to follow the story.

It was great fun welcoming many of our parents and carers into nursery to take part in our 'Stay and Play' (Come and read) session. It was so lovely to see both mums and dads sharing books with a mixture of children. The nursery was full of happy smiles, it's such a treat to have a variety of story tellers in the building, thank you all.
