

The Lawns Nursery School Our Three Nursery Rules

Ready 

- to listen
- for lunchtime and snack- wash hands
- to go outside- put on coat, hat, wellies
- to go home

Respectful 

- tidy up together
- share and be kind
- use gentle hands
- use quiet voice inside
- look after resources and belongings

Safe 

- use walking feet
- sit down to eat
- handle tools safely
- use resources safely

Try using the language of ready, respectful, safe at home. We use it to praise our children all the time! For example, when sharing with another child we would say, "Wow, you're being so respectful towards your friend." Or when getting their coat to go outside or go home we would say, "Well done, you're ready to go..."
