Monday 13th July to Friday 17th July

We have had such an exciting final full week at Nursery. On Wednesday we had a fabulous time meeting and interacting with a wide range of animals from the mobile farm. The children learnt about how to handle the animals and how to be gentle, calm and respectful when around them. Some children enjoyed grooming 'Dandy' the donkey and feeding the pony 'Peggy'. We found out lots of interesting facts about the animals including that Peggy was 25 years old. There were some fluffy chicks which everyone had the opportunity to hold or stroke. We also loved stroking the soft rabbits and guinea pigs. At group time we had learnt about the importance of washing our hands after touching the animals and everyone remembered to do so.

To encourage us to relax at the end of this term we have been participating in some yoga sessions. This has many benefits as it improves our posture, flexibility, strength, balance and co-ordination. It also enhances our sense of well-being, helping us to process our emotions and calm our mind and body. The children impressed us with their ability to hold a variety of poses (e.g. dog, lion, tree) and balancing that can often be tricky.
