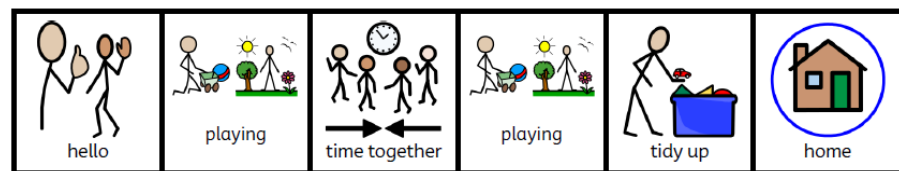
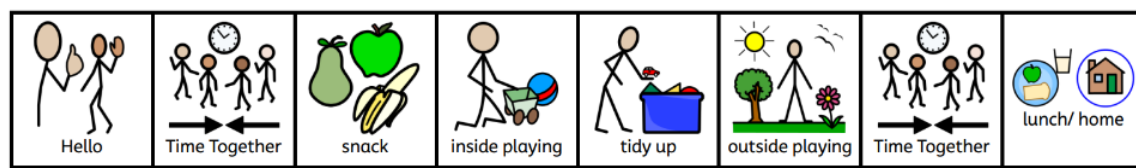


This Week Monday 14th to Friday 18th September
